ANNOUNCEMENT

The Embassy of India is pleased to announce the commitment of the Government of India to extending grant assistance of USD 47,287.18 through the Quick Impact Project (QIP): ***“Sustainable support of chemical teaching laboratory at the Faculty of Mathematics and Natural Sciences (FWNW) of the Anton de Kom University of Suriname (AdeKUS) by amplification of the electrical network and purchase of relevant supplies”.***

The Board of AdeKUS has formally approved the technical specifications and conditions, including the works regarding a major project activity, namely: the expansion of the electrical installation. Quotations to this end, have been solicited from various companies via a tender floated for the project work by FWNW, AdeKUS and 3 companies participated in the tendering, namely (1) M/s. Alginco, (2) M/s AMPS and (3) M/s Elgawa.

After a comprehensive evaluation by a selection commission at AdeKUS, M/S Alginco has been selected for the work, at a cost of US\$ 34,737.18. The technical specifications and the quotation of the successful company are presented below.
