Strengthening friendship with Suriname!

Prime Minister Narendra Modi held bilateral talks with the President of Suriname, H.E. Chandrikapersad Santokhi on 20 November 2024 in Georgetown.

The leaders reviewed bilateral relations in sectors such as trade, technology, energy, telemedicine and more. They also discussed ways to further improve cultural as well as people to people ties.

India will keep supporting various development related initiatives in Suriname.

Prime Minister addresses G-20 session on Sustainable Development and Energy Transition

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi addressed the session of the G 20 Summit on Sustainable Development and Energy Transition. Prime Minister noted that during the New Delhi G 20 Summit, the group had resolved to triple renewable energy capacity and double the energy efficiency rate by 2030. He welcomed Brazil's decision to take forward these sustainable development priorities.

Prime Minister elaborated on the steps taken by India to foster sustainable development. He stated that India had provided housing to 40 million families in the last ten years; 120 million households with clean drinking water in the last five years; 100 million families with clean cooking fuel and 115 million families with toilets.



Ambassador meets Vice President Brunswijk



Ambassador Subhash Gupta paid a courtesy call on and held a discussion with the Vice President of Suriname, H.E. Ronnie Brunswijk, covering a wide range of matters of bilateral cooperation.

Vice President Brunswijk assured the Ambassador of his support in advancing the bilateral ties between India and Suriname.

The meeting took place on 13 November 2024 at the office of the Vice President of Suriname.



Ambassador visits Alpha Max Academy

Ambassador Subhash Gupta visited the Alpha Max Academy, an international school in Paramaribo on 8 November and presented some books for setting up an "India Corner" in the school library. He also garlanded the bust of Gurudev Tagore located in the school premises.





Embassy organised a DVC with Dr. The Most Honourable Jerome Walcott, Minister of Health and Wellness of Barbados on 7 November 2024. High Commissioner designate highlighted the potential healthcare collaborations with India. The discussion covered a wide array of subjects, including collaboration and partnership in the pharmaceutical industry, acceptance of Indian Pharmacopeia, replication of affordable medicine schemes like the Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Jan Aushadhi Pariyojana in the partner country through agreement, and the trade of medical machinery to improve healthcare infrastructure. Key points also included addressing labor migration and healthcare worker support, the use of mobile hospitals like the BHISHM Cube for remote areas, access to diabetes and hemodialysis machines, sharing of technology in cancer treatment and radiotherapy, and the potential for sea ambulance services to improve emergency response in island nation.



UN Resident Coordinator Ms. Joanna Kazan resident in Port of Spain called on Amb. Subhash Gupta yesterday. Discussions covered various UN projects in Suriname as well as about the India-UNDP funded projects.



Members of the Indian Diaspora community along with Officials of the Embassy of India and SVCC witnessed live stream of the joint launch of the website for the 18th Pravasi Bharatiya Divas- 2025 (#PBD) by EAM Dr S. Both sides exchanged views on cooperation in the fields of capacity building, education, health, cricket, and yoga and stressed the need to further reinforce bilateral relations.

PM Narendra Modi and PM Mia Amor Mottley of Barbados met on the margins of the 2nd India-CARICOM Summit in Georgetown.

During the meeting, Prime Minister of Barbados announced the decision of her government to confer on the Prime Minister the Honorary Order of Freedom of Barbados Award, recognizing his leadership in assisting Barbadosduring the Covid 19 pandemic and commitment to India-Barbados ties. The award will be bestowed on 30 Nov 2024 in Barbados.

This high-level engagement provided an opportunity for both leaders to reaffirm and strengthen the India-Barbados relationship, while reviewing ongoing cooperation across several key areas, including health & pharma and collaboration at the United Nations.



High Commissioner Subhash P. Gupta presented his letter of credence to H.E. Dame Sandra Prunella Mason, FB, GCMG, DD, SC,LLD and the President of Barbados at the State House in Bridgetown followed by a Tete-a-tete with the President. HC conveyed the greetings of Indian leadership, and his commitment to further strengthen, deepen and expand the cordial relations between India-Barbados.

75th Constitution Day commemorated in Paramaribo





On the occasion of 75th Constitution Day a short documentary film was screened at SVCC followed by Ambassador's remarks on salient feature of Constitution of India.

The Embassy officials and staffs led by Ambassador Subhash Gupta read out the Preamble of the Constitution of India and took a pledge to promote the values enshrined in the Constitution.

Miss Mia Ámor Mottley and had a fruitful discussion covering wide range of matters of mutual intrest on 29 November 2024. High Commissioner conveyed that he would also ensure that bilateral relations grow from strength to strength.

Ramji, Second Secretary participated in the discussions. The meeting focused on Barbados proposal for supply of machinery from India for small and medium enterprises sector in Barbados.
